



Mild chickpea and mango curry

6 portions

Ingredients

240g Tinned chickpeas drained 120g Mango chunks 120g Onion, very fine dice or grated 80g Cauliflower, very small florets 220g Tinned tomatoes 100ml Water

> 40g Fresh tomatoes, cut into wedges or chunks 80g Green peppers, very fine dice 80g Sweetcorn, frozen Small bunch of Coriander,

½ tsp Mild curry powder
½ clove Garlic, crushed and chopped.
2 tsp Sunflower oil

- Wash the coriander under cold water, dry then finely chop the stalks and leaves separately and store for later
- 2. Measure out the curry powder
- 3. Prepare the vegetables, as stated in the ingredient column
- 4. Heat the oil in a large pan over a medium heat.
- 5. Add the onion and green peppers and fry for 5 minutes until slightly coloured
- 6. Add the garlic and coriander stalks, and fry for another 30 seconds.
- 7. Add the curry powder and fry for a few minutes stirring continually
- 8. Turn the heat up to high, add the tinned tomatoes and bring to a boil
- 9. Add all other remaining curry ingredients except for the coriander leaves and tomato wedges, bring back to the boil, then turn down to a simmer until all the fruit and vegetables are cooked
- 10. Stir through the tomato wedges and chopped coriander leaves, simmer for 5 more minutes
- 11. Serves perfectly with boiled rice
